Torah Day School uses a **Student Centered Approach to Torah Education (SCATE)** that is best implemented in a safe, growth-minded environment, where students feel valued and therefore ready to actively participate in learning.

### TDSA STUDENTS LEARN AND THRIVE FROM:

- Comprehensive Judaic Studies including *kriah v'ksiva* (Hebrew reading, comprehension, and writing), *moadim* (customs about the holidays, Shabbat, and the Jewish calendar), *halachah* (Jewish laws, customs, and how to behave), Jewish history, Tanakh and Talmud.
- Rigorous academics including literature-based Humanities, the Tang Math method, discovery-based science, and STEAM.
- Age-appropriate lessons that sequentially build on the previous years.
- Hands-on activities, creative projects, and thoughtful discussions.
  - Our Social and Emotional Learning program (SEL) encourages empathy and self awareness, and provides children with age-appropriate ways to manage emotions and build lasting friendships.
- Learning skills and technology that are used in all disciplines to infuse collaboration, creativity, and critical thinking.

Through sports, our coaches teach the students the value of teamwork, sportsmanship, integrity, and hard work.

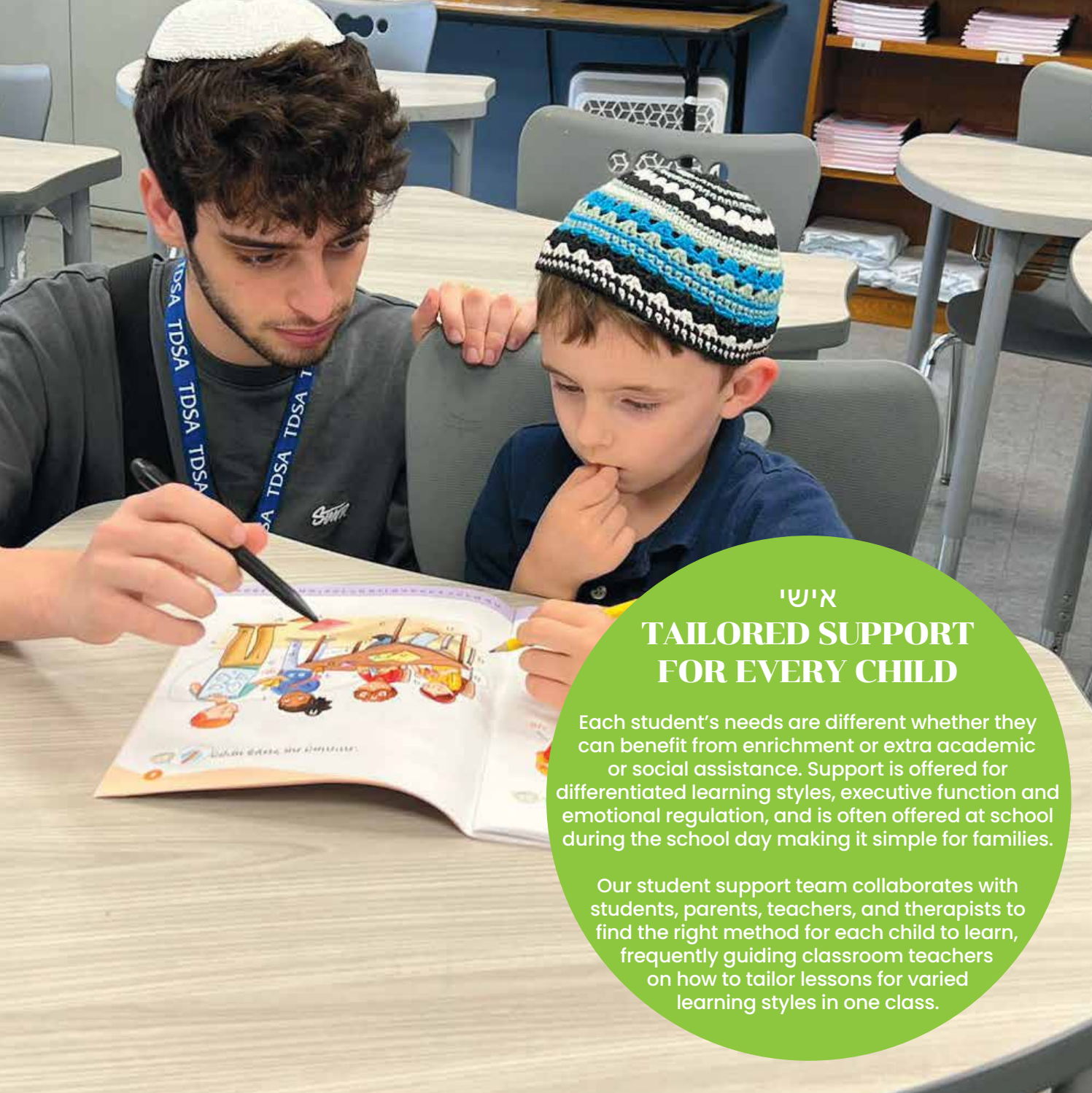
